Student Satisfaction Survey Report

Academic Year 2018-19

1. 84% of the students have answered that 70-100 percentage of the syllabus was covered by the teachers in the class.
2. 90% students have answered that teachers were thoroughly & satisfactorily prepared for their classes.
3. Regarding the ability of communication of teachers, 88% respondents are of the view that teachers were found to be always effective and good in communication with students.
4. 97% respondents have answered that teachers' approach of teaching was excellent, very good and good at the time of explaining the content.
5. Regarding the fairness of the internal evaluation, 75% students are of the view that it is always fair and usually fair.
6. Regarding the discussions on performance by students, 92% respondents are of the view that every time and usually teachers discuss about their performance in assignments.
7. Regarding Institution's role, 85% respondents are of the view that institute regularly and often shows active interest in promoting internship, student's field visit opportunities.
8. Almost 85% respondents expressed that teaching and monitoring process in institute facilitates them significantly and very well in cognitive, social and emotional growth.
9. Regarding the institution, 78% students agree and strongly agree that multiple opportunities are provided by institution to learn and grow.
10. Almost 80% respondents are of the view that the teachers inform them usually and every time about expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes.
11. 84% respondents are of the view that every time and usually, their mentor does necessary follow-up with assignment task given to them.
12. 93% respondents are of the view that their teachers illustrate the concept every time and usually through examples and applications.

13. 80% respondents are of the view that the teachers identify their strengths fully, reasonably and encourage them with providing right-level challenges.
14. Almost 81% respondents have said that every time and usually, their teachers are able to identify their weakness and help them to overcome.
15. Almost 85% respondents agree or strongly agree about the efforts made by institution to engage students in monitoring review and improving quality of teaching-learning process continuously.
16. 84% respondents are of the view that the institution and teachers use student-centric methods such as experimental learning, participation of students and problem solving methodologies to a great extent and moderate level to enhance learning experiences.
17. Almost 87% respondents agree or strongly agree that encouragement is provided to them in participating in extra-curricular activities.
18. Almost 68% respondents are of the view that institute/teachers take efforts to a great extent and moderate level to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them able to face the work world.
19. 69% respondents have responded that about 70-100% teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia, etc. while teaching.
20. 78% respondents agree or strongly agree with the statement that the overall quality of teaching-learning process in their institution is very good.
